We've created this easy-to-use web design tool exclusively for central stations and dealers! It's designed to help your company stand out with a customized look on the Total Connect website. While the login page will remain the same, the pages can be unique to your company image. You'll be able to create a custom header – including an uploadable image – and can change the text and font to what you'd like to reflect your company. Below are the size limits for uploaded images:

- Header image maximum size is 760 x 200 pixels
- Introduction image maximum size is 250 x 150 pixels




Designing a Header
