Entering Conditions for Contact ID

When entering Contact ID conditions, you must define the following:

- The zones that will be reporting (with partitions, if used)
- The events that will be reported for these zones

If you are setting up a Burglar system with 3 zones:

Zone 001 – Front Door Zone 002 – Motion Detector Zone 003 – Back Door

you would have to enter the event code for a Burglar alarm (see CID Table) for these three zones:

To make the entry of these conditions even easier – or if you are unsure of exactly which specific Contact ID code will come in (i.e., 131 vs. 135), you could enter these same conditions, using wildcards, as such:
